PROVINCIAL FIRE SERVICE AWARD REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The Provincial Fire Service Award is presented by the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador and is administered by Fire and Emergency Services (FES), Fire Services Division.
- 2. Persons entitled to the Provincial Fire Service Award shall make written application to FES, except as noted in sentence 8, under posthumous awards.
- 3. For the applicant to be eligible for a service award, a letter from the fire chief must accompany the application acknowledging proof of length of service years.
- 4. Applications will not be processed until after the time is served for each individual service award. There are no exceptions to this requirement.
- 5. A person receiving an award will have served in a facet of the fire service for at least 20 years since January 1, 1955. The total time may be achieved by volunteer or paid service or a combination of both. Service time need not be continuous; however, temporary or long term leave of absence is not considered time served.
- 6. If a firefighter is on long term leave due to an injury as a result of his/her duties as a firefighter, leave would be considered as time served.
- 7. All service years must have been accumulated in Newfoundland and Labrador.
- 8. Where the qualifying person is deceased, and completed his/her years of fire service since January 1, 1985, the next of kin may apply for the award posthumously.
